

Henry Armstrong

In September of the same year [1778] he was drafted under **Capt. Cravens** and went from Rockingham County to Fort Pitt, crossed the Ohio River and built Fort McIntosh. He was under Col. Crawford and **Maj. Palmeto**. They then marched about 70 miles, crossed the Tuscaroring [sic] River and built a small fort.

Henry Armstrong of Adair Co., Ky., private in company of **Capt. Goodson** in regiment of **Col. Smith** in Virginia Line for nine months, was placed on the Kentucky pension roll at \$30 per annum under Act of 1832. Certificate 25036 was issued 12 Nov. 1833.

Armstrong applied for his pension on 2 Oct. 1833. At the time he claimed he was 79 years old.
